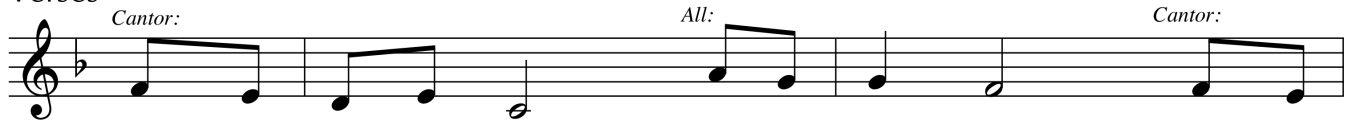

now and for ev-er.

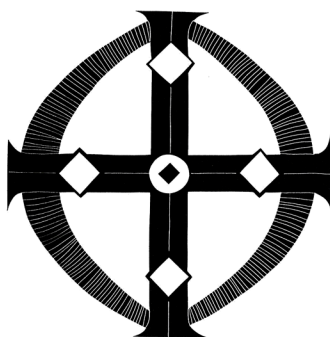
BLESSING
