that our mouths may proclaim your praise.

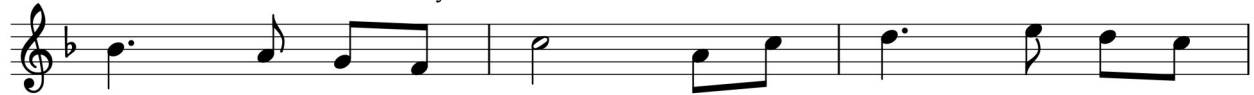

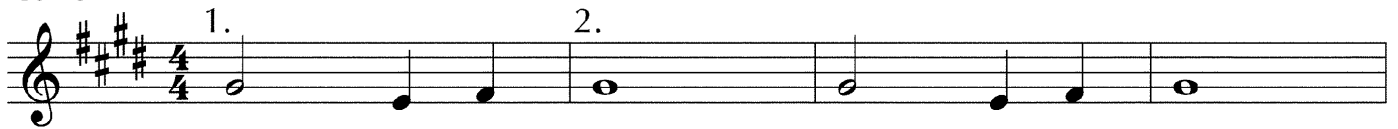

When I awake I shall be satisfied, beholding your likeness.

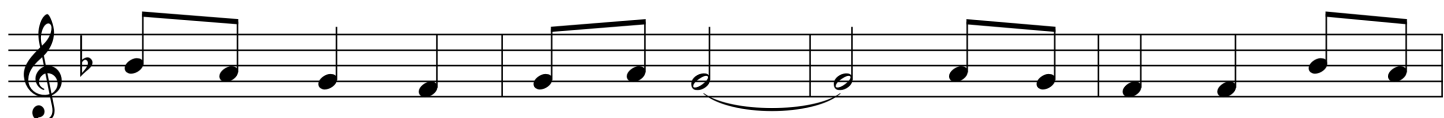


