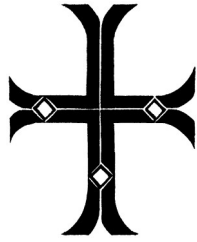

CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

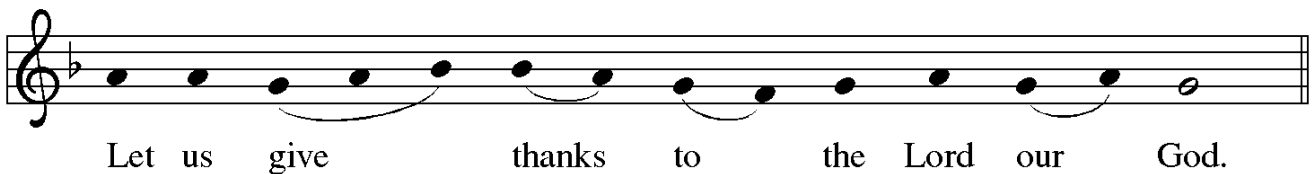
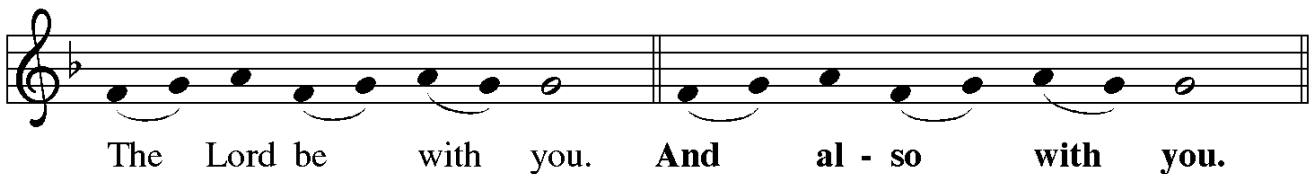
Blessed be the holy Trinity, † one God, who looks upon us in compassion, forgives our sin, and heals our lives. **Amen.**

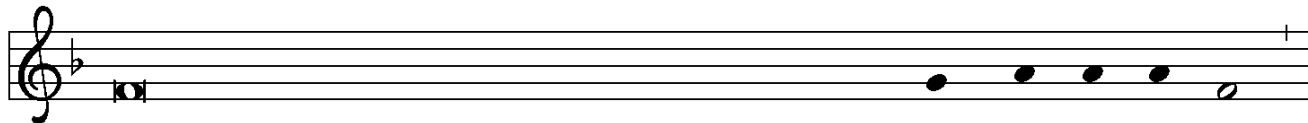
Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another.

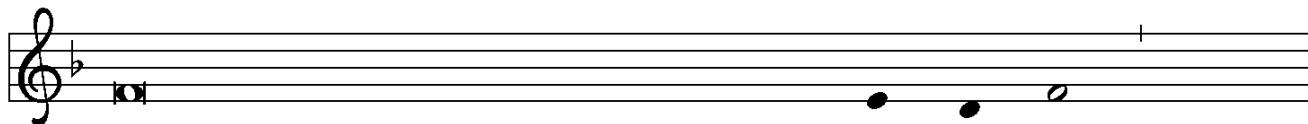

THANKSGIVING FOR LIGHT

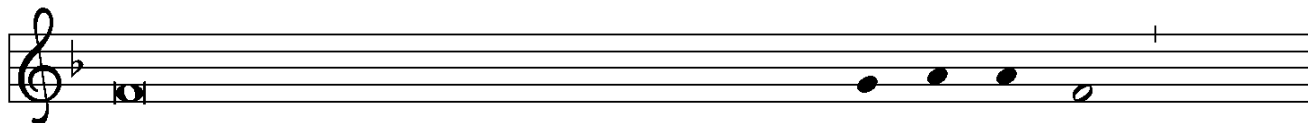




We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning you called light in - to being,

you led your peo - ple in - to freedom.



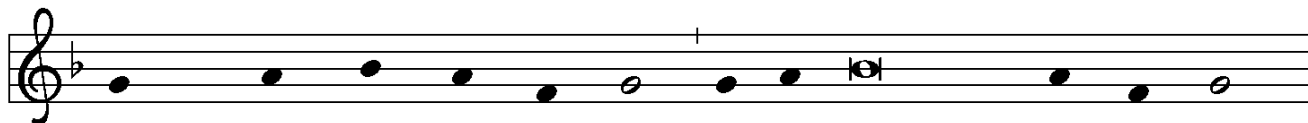
Enlighten our darkness by the light of your Christ; may your Word be

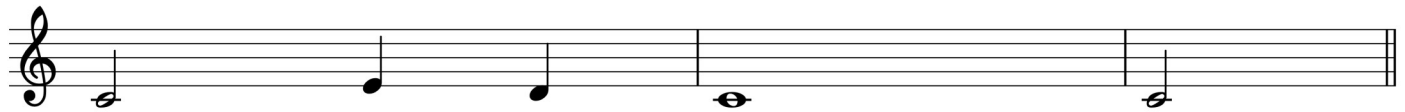

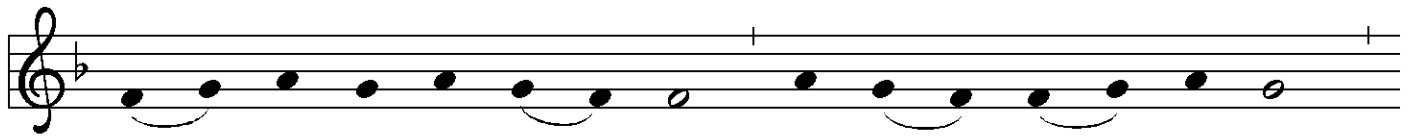
