PSALM PRAYER

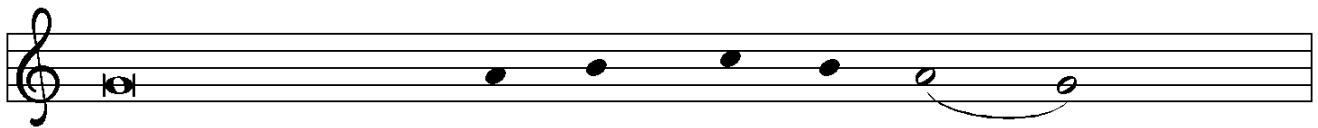
