

## Holtkamp Organ, 1969

Cleveland, Ohio

The Holtkamp mechanical action organ was installed in 1969. Installed in the rear gallery of the church, the organ is a two manual instrument with 34 ranks of pipes. It replaced an electronic instrument which had been in use for five years after the congregation moved to its present location.

In 2004 the organ was rebuilt and enlarged by the Andover Organ Company. Repairs were made to the wind chests and the action, and pipes cleaned and repaired as needed. Four additional stops were added and the organ was regulated for volume and balance in the sanctuary. The new pipes add to the tonal palette of the organ, but the essential character of the original Holtkamp organ was retained.

Andover also rebuilt the three stop Steinmann portative organ in 2003. This one manual organ was purchased in 1967 and is used primarily in the chapel and can be moved into the sanctuary when needed.
